



COLORADO DESIGN COMPETITION

Purpose: To encourage Health Science students to create a design using the current national theme.

Description of Event: This event involves a HOSA member creating a design depicting the current national theme. The selected design may be used in a conference program and displayed on the Colorado HOSA website.

- Rules and Procedures**
1. Competitors in this event must be active members of HOSA in good standing in the category in which they are registered to compete (Secondary or Postsecondary/Collegiate).
 2. The poster design must be original art work of the HOSA member. The design must depict the current national theme, found at www.hosa.org.
 3. Copyrighted characters or trademarks may not be used (e.g.: "Peanuts" cartoon).
 4. The design must be computer generated.
 5. The design must be e-mailed as an attachment to the Colorado HOSA State Advisor by the established deadline. The body of the e-mail must include:
 - a. Name of member (artist)
 - b. Name of chapter
 6. An e-mail receipt will be sent, confirming the receipt of the design.
 7. The winning design will be announced and posted on the website.
 8. The winning design may be used on a conference program and on the website.
 9. Competitors must be familiar with and adhere to the "**General Rules and Regulations of the National HOSA Competitive Events Program.**"
