

**Colorado HOSA Fall Leadership Conference with the Denver Nuggets
Frequently Asked Questions**

Q: How much does the Fall Leadership Conference cost?

A: \$55 for all attendees; including advisors, students and chaperones if the fees are postmarked by October 30th. After October 30th, the registration fee is \$65.

Q: What does the registration fee cover?

A: The registration fee covers the cost of the Denver Nuggets game ticket, lunch, speaker fees and materials for the conference.

Q: Is the Fall Leadership Conference just for chapter officers?

A: No. The Fall Leadership Conference is open to all HOSA members and all potential HOSA members.

Q: Can others (parents, administrators, etc) purchase tickets for the Nuggets game?

A: Yes. Tickets for the game are available for \$25. See the registration form for a place for additional ticket purchases. (See below for clarification of conference/game prices...)

Q: Can attendees just pay for the day part of the conference and not the ticket to the game?

A: No. In order for a person to attend the conference and be in the Pepsi Center, the attendee needs to have a ticket to the game for that evening.

Q: I don't understand the registration form. What information do you need?

A: Fill out the attendee's name and if they are a student or adult (you may use S or A to designate these). The release form and fee boxes you may use as a check box to mark off when a student's form and fee have been collected. At the bottom of the form, indicate the number of FLC attendees and extra game tickets and a total fee. If you have multiple registration forms, you may just use the fee portion on one of the forms for the entire group.

Q: Can the registration form be e-mailed?

A: Yes, you may e-mail completed registration forms to Jen Staley at Jennifer.staley@cccs.edu. However, registration will not be processed until payment and release forms are received.

Q: What is the dress code for the conference?

A: Dress for all attendees during the Fall Leadership Conference is business casual. Business casual dress is required. No blue jeans. Dress is to reflect the image of HOSA (no inappropriate slogans, sayings, logos, or images on T-shirts or other clothing; no low-riding pants or skirts that reveal abdomens, navels, mid-backs; no bare mid-sections; no torn or ragged clothing; no hats; no short shorts; no thin strap tops).

Further clarification of dress code:

NOT ALLOWED: blue jeans/denim, beach flip flops

ACCEPTABLE: pants, khakis, nice top, chapter HOSA T-shirts or polo's, tennis shoes (because of walking purposes)

Dress for the Nuggets v Raptors game is casual. Attendees may change after the Courtside Experience. Attendees may also choose to wear the same clothes.

Advisor Note: Please, please, please check dress before transporting students to the Pepsi Center. Many students' and advisors' experience can be ruined by one person who has ignored the dress code. Enforcement of the dress code is the responsibility of the chapter advisor before arriving at the Pepsi Center. Advisors are expected to use this opportunity to discuss proper attire in different settings. The dress code for Fall Leadership Conference is more casual than the State Leadership Conference.

Q: Is dinner provided?

A: No. Lunch will be provided, but dinner is on your own. There are restaurants on 16th Street Mall or Brooklyn's or Braun's across the street. You may find time will not allow for a meal outside of Pepsi Center. The concession stands will be available during the game for food purchases.

Q: Tell me about chaperoning students at the Fall Leadership Conference.

A: Schools are expected to provide adequate chaperones for the entirety of Fall Leadership Conference. Colorado HOSA recommends one chaperone for every 10 students.

Q: What if I have a discipline issue with a student?

A: Each advisor is expected to discuss behavior issues with students attending the Fall Leadership Conference. If a student causes a disturbance or has a behavior issue, the advisor should use school policies to determine a course of action.

Q: Who is leading the Leadership Training?

Q: Can students bring a brown bag lunch or dinner?

A: No, the Pepsi Center does not allow outside food or drinks into the building.

Q: What's the parking situation for the day and evening for buses/cars?

A: There will be no cost for the cars arriving during the morning for our event. They begin charging for parking later in the afternoon. You will not have to move vehicles, but if for some reason you leave and come back later, you will have to pay.

Q: Can I sell the Nuggets tickets for more than \$25 as a fundraiser?

A: No. Tickets can be sold for any amount up to face value (\$25), but it is against Nuggets policy to sell tickets above face value.
